The WJEC Geography specification for Wales introduced in 2016 has seen an increase in Mathematical skills being tested. The weighting of these skills is at least 10% across the series and students need to be familiar with the complete range of techniques listed in the specification. These include some skills of numeracy that may not be commonly used in Geography classrooms at GCSE. This course will be led by a Mathematics specialist who will guide you through each technique to ensure a full and comprehensive understanding.
