Please make sure your child wears their helmet to school. They will not be able to take part in the activities if they do not have one!



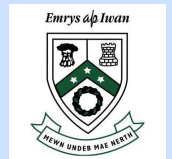
Seeds and Bulbs


21st Century Schools


