


Respecting Others Week

This week we have been doing lots of different activities about respecting others and anti bullying. We have all designed super heroes and in each year group we've talked about different ways to show respect to everyone around us. We've also talked about what to do if someone is being bullied. The School Council presented a special assembly promoting respect and children from each year group spoke about what they'd been doing.

Year 3 have been designing some super Super Heroes who will promote respect.



Year 4 have been using drama to explore different scenarios where someone is being bullied. We have discussed different character thoughts and added words to thought bubbles on a concept cartoon. We have also created our own alternative comic



strips to explain what should have happened in a situation! Lots of collaborative learning and discussion 😊

Year 5 had great fun designing their super hero masks. They did 'super' work on respecting others.



Year 6 have been discussing lots of different statements about whether a situation is bullying or not. We've also shared our thoughts and feelings about different scenarios and how we would react. Superheroes galore have been born to promote respect too! A wonderful respecting others week!
