HOMEWORK

Spellings are given and your child will either have a Daily Diary or Spelling Log in which your child will write their spellings.

This term the project will be working on a project that covers the following areas of the National Curriculum:

Literacy	-	Explanations
Art & Design-		Mosaics/observational drawings
Geography	-	Settlements
History	-	The Romans and the Celts

This project has a history focus and teaches the children about the significance of the Romans, who they were, where they came from and their impact on the Celt population of Wales and Britain.

In this project the children will learn:

- about the historical events associated with the Roman invasion of Britain and Wales and their settlement in these places;
- about the culture, religion, buildings and way of life in Roman Britain, and how the settlement affected the Celtic people;
- how to use a range of sources to gain information about the Celts and Romans;
- how to write informal letters as a historical character.
